Re: Foot and Nail Certification

We want to begin by apologizing for the lack of information that had been passed to you during and after this conference.

Now, we want to clarify how to obtain your certification. The following is a direct quote from an email we received from the WOCNCB regarding this...

"If the attendees are using the course offering as CE credits towards the "Experiential Pathway", it is not necessary to code number the program you conducted. In other words, code numbers are assigned when the program included clinical hours as part of the course and would then be considered a "Formal Education Program." This formal education program is the alternative pathway from the experiential. When they use your CE credits, they should be documenting on their application they are applying via the experiential pathway and list the CE course on the application and include a copy of the CE certificate. They should further document their own clinical hours on the exam application as part two of the experiential pathway. I hope this clarifies the process for you."
